- Plant milkweed for the monarch butterfly.



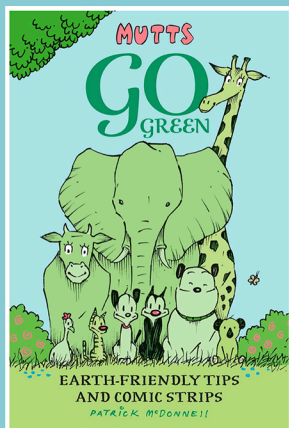
The Orange Bowl Birdfeeder

- Cut an orange in half and gently remove the inside fruit.
- Poke 2 holes in the rind directly across from each other.

- Knot the ends together so the bowl can hang.
- Fill with birdseed or cereal. Serve!
