

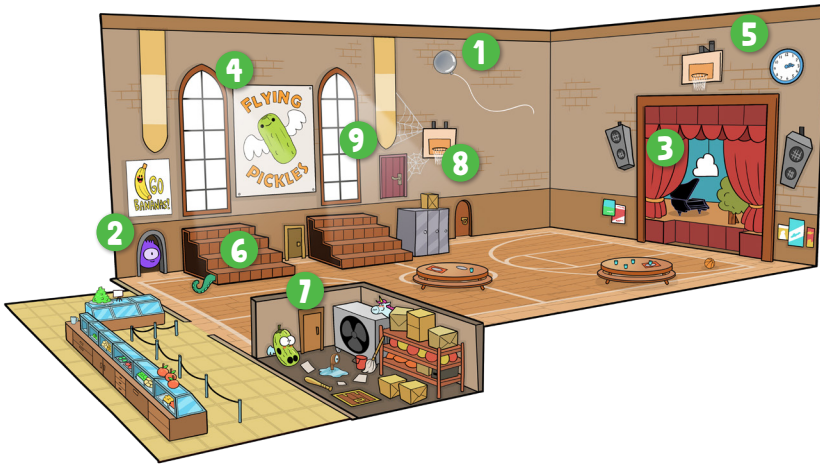


WHAT'S IN YOUR CAFETORIUM?
